Dynamics 365 Finance & Operations licensing changes

- In October 2019 Finance & Operations subscription service licensing was divided into 3 separate apps :
 - Dynamics 365 Finance
 - Dynamics 365 Supply Chain Management
 - Dynamics 365 Commerce
- Wave 1 2020 Release will introduce changes to the user interface and license enforcement based on the new licenses.
- Rather than access to all the functionality - users will only be able to access menu items that their license allows.
- The product name and brand will reflect the license associated with the current user.
- This functionality is controlled by Microsoft and is off by default.
- Microsoft to roll out between April and October 2020.
- Branding changes may be rolled out earlier than license enforcement.

What this means to you

- The subscription services needed for each user will be based on the user's access to functionality.
- You need to review each user's access to the system to ensure your site is correctly licensed so that all users can log in and access the correct app.
- This license audit check should occur before the Microsoft enforcement (between April and October 2020) – (otherwise you may be paying for subscription you don't need).

A compelling reason for action

D365 Wave 1 2020 Release (from April 2020) Microsoft will be enforcing new licensing for Dynamics 365 F&O with 3 separate subscription services:

- Dynamics 365 for finance
- Dynamics 365 for supply chain management
- Dynamics 365 commerce

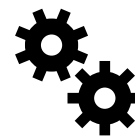
Review your user access now and avoid paying for user access to subscription services you do not need.

DXC D365 Finance Subscription License Review

- Run reports to determine user access setup and system usage (review security roles, functional areas, modifications, third party solution access).
- Review number of each type of user per subscription service
- Compare user count with subscription license purchased
- Determine if current licence is adequate to cover all users
- Identify users for licence optimisation (eg users who could almost become Team/Activity users with a small amount of business process change)
- Document all findings in a comprehensive report with recommended changes and projected reduction in subscription licenses required.



Activity Estimate

- Dependant on the size of the site ranging from approximately 2 days for a small site up to 5 days for a large/complex site
- Work can be done remotely without visiting your site.
